- 1. A mechanical pencil No. 05 or 07, \$5.
- 2. A watercolor field pocket set, Winsor & Newton Cotman 12 half pan \$25
- 3. Watercolor brushes, Round Brushes No. 4 and 6, \$5 \$10 each.
- 4. A few sheets of paper towel
- 5. White or Blue Scotch painting Tape, \$7.
- 6. A flat 8.5 x 11 drawing pad or foam board or cardboard
- 7. An atomizer or a small spray bottle, \$3.
- 8. A few sheet of watercolor paper, 10 x 14 in. Arches, or Fabriano 140 lb, cold press is recommended, \$25.
